

# Researching Century Buildings

- **“Chain of Ownership”**. Establish grantor (seller), grantee (buyer) and date of transfer, incorporating construction date up to current owner.
  - *Stark County Recorder’s Office*. Online deeds.
  - *Stark County Auditors Office*. Written/verbal request to print out “transfer cards.”
  - *Stark County Library – Genealogy Section* has estate (probate) records.
  - *North Canton Heritage Society*. Property abstracts.
  - *McKinley Presidential Library*. Property abstracts.
- **Permanent Parcel number**.
  - *Stark County Auditors Office*. Online search.
- **Year House was Built**.
  - *Stark County Library*. Online search of tax records (1826 to 1838) and deeds. (Note deeds = land not necessarily buildings).
  - *Stark County Auditors Office*. Online information (be careful because the buildings can be “re-dated” when an addition is added). Provides building progression (additions) of structure. Written requests can be made for tax records.
- **Maps Showing Property**.
  - *Stark County Library – Genealogy Section*.
  - *North Canton Heritage Society*.
  - *Fire Insurance Maps*.
- **Historic Photos of Property**.

- **Genealogy Section** (2<sup>nd</sup> Floor). Copy machine available. Can transfer most information onto a flash drive.
  - Maps. Can copy on copy machine.
  - Ancestry.com (Free)
  - Estate (Probate) Records. Submit a written request. Provided with original documents for viewing and copying.
  - Deeds. Book Index (grantor/grantee). Written deeds available on micro fish (can print out or copy to a flash drive).
  - Tax Records. 1810-1825 do not include indication of buildings. 1826-1838 buildings are indicated. 1839-? Records are not available.
  - Obituaries. Online.

- Deeds. Public research room with computers and a printer. Can submit a written request for staff to try to improve the quality of copy of the deed by accessing the original. 24-48 hours to process the request.

- Building Date. Online research using property address or current owners name. This date might not be the original date of the structure, but the date of a later addition.
- Parcel Number. Online research (same as above).
- Property Ownership Transfer Cards. Verbal/Written requests. Chain of ownership only goes back so far though.
- Tax Records. Submit written research request for a few specific years, *but not several*.
